

Pavilions: Questions & Answers

1. Q: Do the pavilions have electricity?

A: Northeast, Keystone, Commonwealth and Midway pavilions at Adams-Ricci all have one 120-amp outlet. Acri Meadow Park also has an electrical outlet on the shed next to the pavilion. Citizens & West Enola pavilions at Adams-Ricci DO NOT have electricity. Summerdale, Ridley Creekside and the West Fairview Annex pavilions also DO NOT have electricity.

2. Q: What do I do with the trash/recycling?

A: Place trash and recyclables in proper containers. Excess waste can be bagged and placed next to receptacles. A fee will be assessed if the pavilion is not cleaned after your reservation.

3. Q: Can I bring a grill?

A: Yes. Charcoal grills are also available for use at each pavilion. Leave coal in grills. Maintenance workers will remove coals the next day.

4. Q: How many picnic tables are under the pavilion?

A: There are approximately 8-10 tables at each of the pavilions at Adams-Ricci Park. Please make sure that the tables are in the same position as they were when you arrived.

5. Q: What is the policy on decorations?

A: No confetti. Signs, balloons, and other decorations are permitted as long as they are removed from the pavilion and park before you leave.

6. Q: Are Bounce Houses, Pony Rides or Slip & Slides permitted?

A: Bounce Houses, Pony Rides, Petting Zoos and Slip & Slides are NOT allowed for insurance reasons. Reserving a pavilion does not guarantee the use of the surrounding area. If you would like to ensure use of a field, please contact the Recreation Department.

7. Q: Can we bring extra tents?

A: Setting up pop-up tents around the pavilion is permitted with prior permission from the Recreation Department.

8. Q: What is the smoking policy?

A: We have adopted a 'Young Lungs at Play' program. Please refrain from smoking at the park.

9. Q: What is the alcohol policy?

A: Alcohol is not permitted anywhere in the park.

10. Q: What if it rains on the date of my pavilion reservation?

A: Call the Recreation Office and we can transfer your reservation to another available date.

Cancellations will result in a partial refund. There is a \$15.00 nonrefundable administrative fee.

11. Q: What should I do if someone is at the pavilion when I arrive?

A: A yellow 'RESERVED' sign will be posted on the day of your event. A copy of your receipt and permit would have been emailed to you for proof of payment and reservation. If the problem cannot be resolved, please call the EPPD at 717-732-3633 for the on-duty officer.

Always let the Recreation Department know of any problems that you encountered during your rental so that we can remedy any issues.
